Mrs. Nicolasa Flores is a 76-year-old female who admitted to Park Manor CyFair on April 19th following a hospital stay at Memorial Hermann Greater Heights. She was diagnosed with a right femur fracture following a fall. Mrs. Flores was evaluated by Physical and Occupational therapy services.

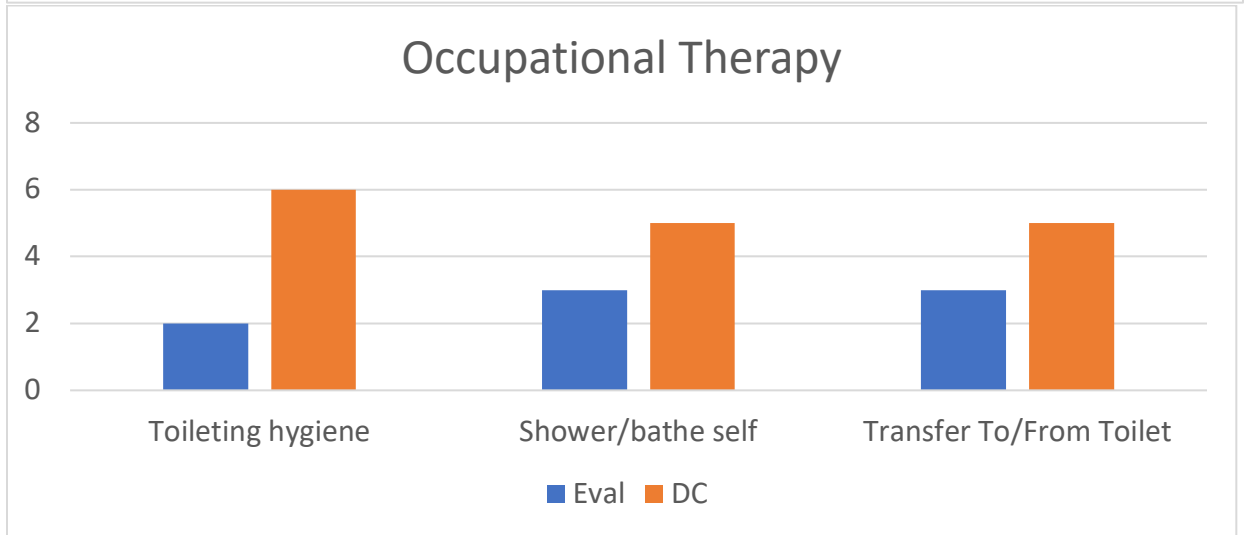
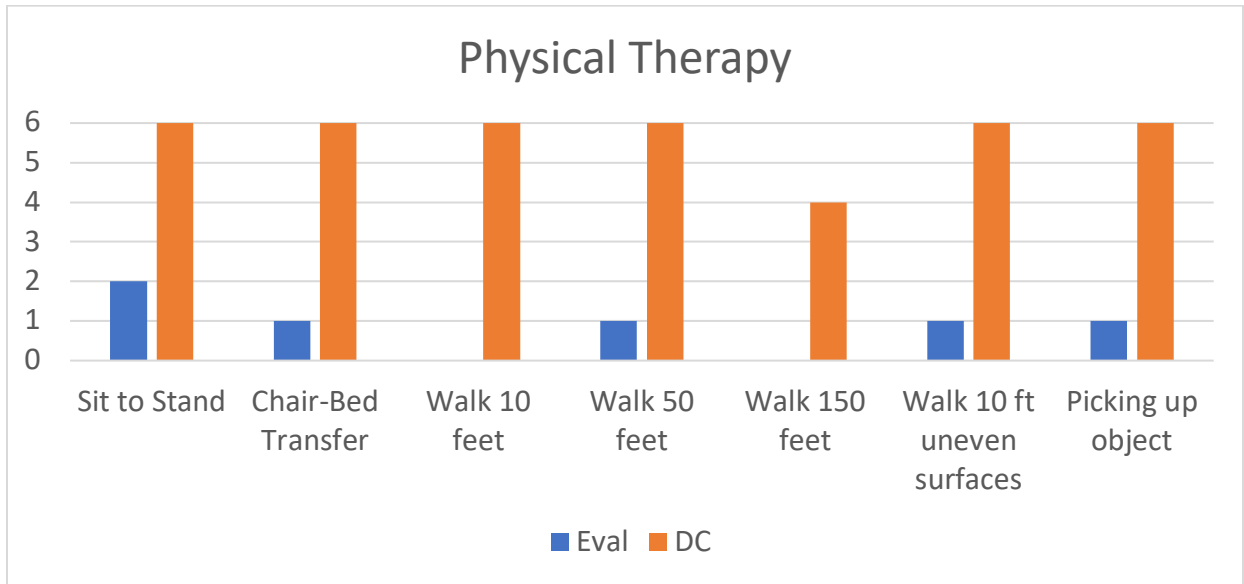
The initial assessments indicated that she was moderate assistance for bed mobility, Min A for transfers, SBA for self-feeding, Min A for toileting, SBA for UB dressing, Mod A for LB dressing and unable to ambulate.

Skilled therapy services are warranted to access functional abilities, increase functional mobility, increase independence with gait and improve ADL function to return home.

Physical and Occupational therapy created plans of care that were individualized for Mr. Flores and following 16 days of skilled rehabilitation she was able to safely return home with increased functional mobility and ADL function.

Mrs. Flores increased her bed mobility to Min A, transfers wit SBA, Self-feeding to Independent, toileting to Modified Independent, UB dressing to Modified Independent, LB dressing to Supervision and able to ambulate with a 75dt with a RW with SBA.

Mrs. Flores worked extremely hard and was able to achieve her goal of returning home. Congratulation Mrs. Flores! We are proud of you!



MDS Section GG Functional Scores	
06 - Independent	Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
05 - Setup or clean-up assistance	Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
04 - Supervision or touching assistance	Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
03 - Partial/moderate assistance	Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.
02 - Substantial/maximal assistance	Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.
01 - Dependent	Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
