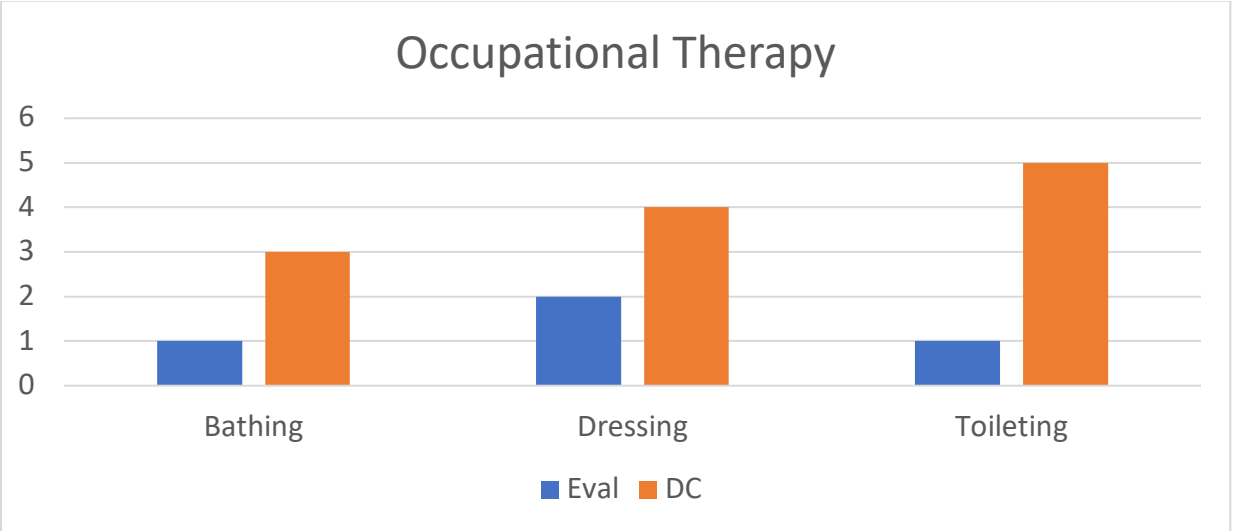
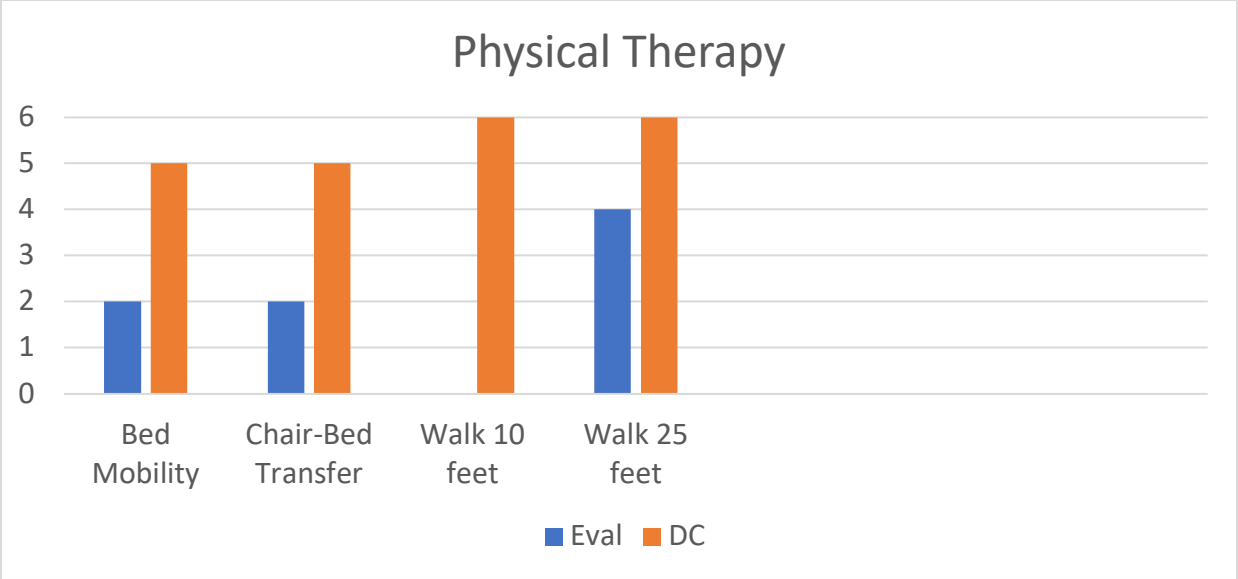


Mr. Ruben Cantu is an 87-year-old who admitted to Park Manor on May 23rd following a stay at North Cypress Medical Center after being diagnosed with covid following a previous stay at a different facility. Mr. Cantu was evaluated by Physical and Occupational therapy services. The initial assessments indicated he was Mod A for bed mobility, Mod A for transfers, Max A for toileting, total for bathing, Mod A for UB dressing, total for LB dressing and able to take 2-3 steps at bedside with Mod A.

Skilled therapy services are warranted to access functional abilities, increase functional activity tolerance, increase independence with gait and improve ADL function to return home.

Physical and Occupational therapy created plans of care that were individualized for Mr. Cantu and following 16 days of skilled rehabilitation he was able to safely return home with increased functional mobility.

He increased his bed mobility to CGA, transfers to Min A, toileting to Min A, Bathing to Mod A, UB dressing to Set-Up, LB dressing to Mod A and able to ambulate with a RW 25 ft with Min A. Mr. Cantu worked hard and was able to achieve his goal of returning home. Great Job Mr. Cantu!



MDS Section GG Functional Scores	
06 - Independent	Completes the activity by him/herself with no assistance from a helper
05 - Setup or clean-up assistance	Helper sets up or cleans up; patient completes activity. Helper assists only prior to or following the activity.
04 - Supervision or touching assistance	Helper provides verbal cues and/or touching/steadying and/or contact guard assistance as patient completes activity. Assistance may be provided throughout the activity or intermittently.
03 - Partial/moderate assistance	Helper does LESS THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts, holds, or supports trunk or limbs, but provides less than half the effort.
02 - Substantial/maximal assistance	Helper does MORE THAN HALF the effort. Helper lifts or holds trunk or limbs and provides more than half the effort.
01 - Dependent	Helper does ALL of the effort. Patient does none of the effort to complete the activity. Or the assistance of 2 or more helpers is required for the patient to complete the activity.
